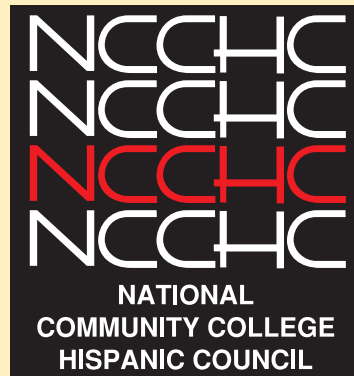

## Membership Information

**Institutional Membership:** Community, Junior and Technical Colleges as well as similar collegiate institutions and organizations that qualify for institutional membership. Mailings/information will go to the representative (usually the campus president) noted on the membership application/renewal form. This level of membership allows your institution to send multiple representatives to the NCCCHC Leadership Symposium and to the AACC Convention at the discounted rates.

**Individual Membership:** Trustees, faculty members, administrators and other staff members of institutions of higher education that qualify for institutional membership. Individual membership allows other institutional member representatives to receive mailings/information and website "members only" access in addition to the key contact person (if the institution is also a member). Individual memberships transfer to other schools with the individual. An individual membership also qualifies member to attend the NCCCHC Leadership Symposium at the member rate even if the institution is not a member.

**Student Membership:** Currently enrolled students of institutions of higher education that qualify for institutional membership. Student memberships transfer to other schools. A student membership also qualifies member to attend the NCCCHC Leadership Symposium at the member rate even if the institution is not a member.
